Divisions:

Players wanting to play up a division must meet a minimum rating requirement, and be approved by the Quincy Park District Little League. We will try to accommodate requests, but we also must maintain the quality of competition in each division. Players playing up may only be eligible for post season selection in their original division, as these all-star teams are based on age. Players may only play on 1 post season team.

Beginner:

Players age 7 & 8. This division will be machine pitch. Teams are required to have 3 adult coaches. There must be an adult in the dugout at all times. There is no post season tournament for this division.

Minors:

Players ages 9-11. This division is player pitch. Mound is 46' & bases are 60'. Teams are required to have 3 adult coaches. There must be an adult in the dugout at all times. 9/10 all-star team will be selected from this division. **If** a 10/11 post season team is selected, players from **both majors and minors** will be eligible. Post season tournament concludes at the state level.

Majors:

Players ages 10-12. This division is player pitch. Mound is 46', bases are 60'. Players age 10 & 11 must rate above 15 to participate in this division. All 12 year olds are eligible to play in this division. Teams are required to have 3 adult coaches. There must be an adult in the dugout at all times. 11/12 yr. old All Star team will be selected from this division. This team will compete in the one and only Little League World Series that concludes in Williamsport, Pennsylvania, and is seen by millions on ESPN and ABC!
