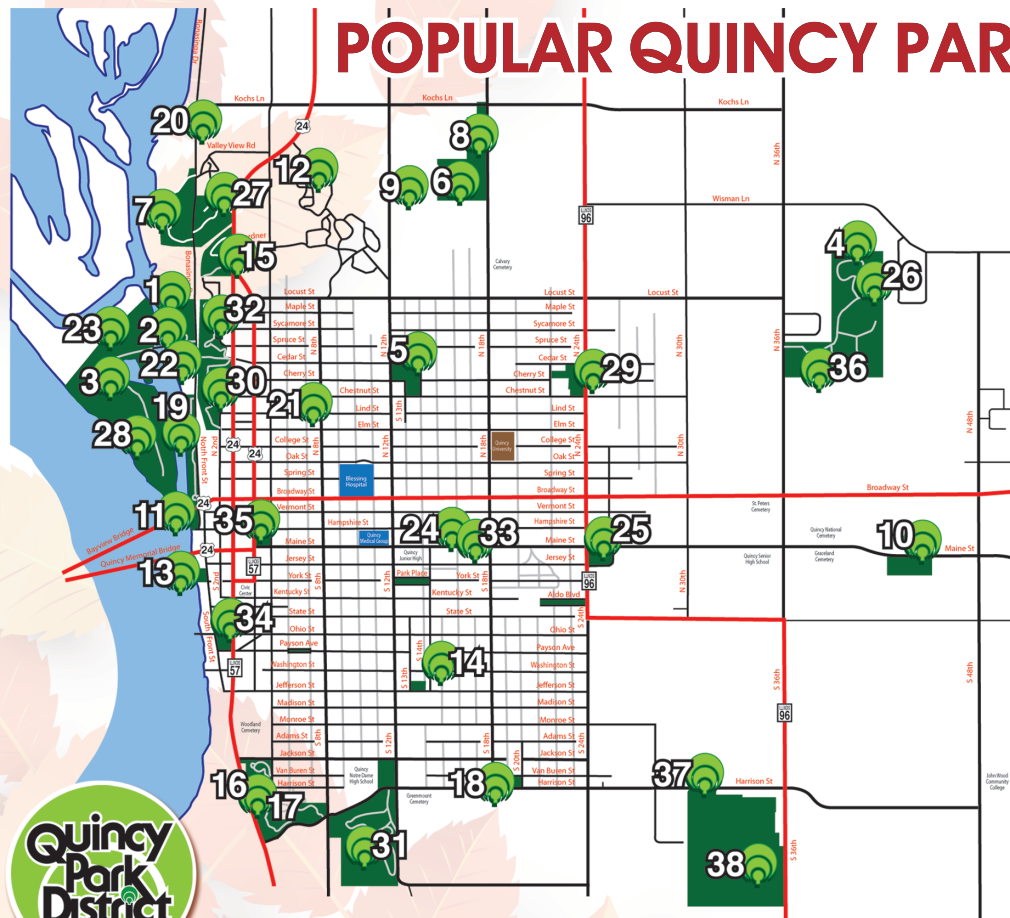

POPULAR QUINCY PARK INFORMATION



1 Administrative Office

Located at 1231 Bonansinga Drive.

2 All America Park

Located on 17 acres on the banks of the Quincy Bay, at Front & Cedar Streets.

3 Art Keller Marina

Located on Quinsippi Island offering 257 boat slips.

4 Batting Cage Area

Located in Upper Moorman Park, this area features batting cages, mini golf, disc golf & concessions.

5 Berrian Park

Located on 12 acres at 14th & Chestnut, Berrian park features an outdoor basketball court, baseball diamond, soccer field & pickle ball courts.

6 Bill Klingner Trail

Asphalt-covered trail located near Bob May Park at 18th & Kochs Lane. The trail stretches between N. 5th & 18th Streets.

7 Bob Bangert Park

Located on 26 acres on the North Bottom Road near the Mississippi River.

8 Bob Mays Park

Located on 53 acres at 18th & Kochs Lane, also the 18th street trail head for the Bill Klingner Trail, and offers an 18-hole disc golf course.

9 Boehl Memorial Park

Located on 14 acres on the south end of Bob Mays Park, and extends from 12th to 18th Streets.

10 Boots Bush Park

Located on 14 acres at 42nd & Maine and features a baseball diamond & soccer fields.

11 Clat Adams Bicentennial Park

Located on 2 acres at Front & Hampshire at Quincy's riverfront, with a large gazebo and decorative fountain.

12 Deer Park

Located on 5 acres on the grounds of the Illinois Veterans Home, near 12th & Locust, features a deer herd along with exotic animals and fowl.

13 Edgewater Park

Located at Front & York Streets.

14 Emerson Park

Located on 1 acre at 1310 Washington, features a playground.

15 Gardner Park

Located on 43 acres at 3rd Street just north of Locust. Features a shelter house with picnic tables and a grill.

16-17 Indian Mounds Park & Pool

Consists of 37 acres at 5th & Harrison and is home to Indian Mounds Pool. Quincy's first public swimming pool.

18 Johnson Park

Located on 9 acres at 18th & Harrison and features a basketball court, horseshoe pits and a playground.

19 Kesler Park

Located on 11 acres on Bonansinga Drive just north of Clat Adams Park on Quincy's riverfront.

20 Lenane Park

Located just north of Bob Bangert Park, offers a peaceful turnoff from Bonansinga Drive.

21 Leon Bailey Park

Located on 1 acre at 7th & Elm, features a playground

22 Lincoln Park

A 12 acre area on the riverfront next to the park district's administrative offices, and is home to the Kiwanis Centennial Playground and skate park.

23 Log Cabin Village

Located on Quinsippi Island, features Lincoln-era cabins, church, and stone smoke house.

24 Lorenzo Bull House

Located at 1550 Maine, is open to the public for private parties & special events. Located in the Lorenzo Bull Park.

25 Madison Park

Located on 9 acres at 24th & Maine, Madison Park is the location for park band concerts.

26 Moorman Park

Located on 80 acres off North 39th Street, it is also known as Lower & Upper Moorman Parks. Home of Pepsi Field.

27 Parker Heights

Located on 23 acres on North Bottom Road. Closed to vehicular traffic, walk the winding paths for the most scenic views in Quincy. This is also part of the Bill Klingner Trail.

28 Quinsippi Island

An island that features more than 130 scenic acres on the Mississippi river across from All America Park.

29 Reservoir Park

Located on 11 acres at 24th & Chestnut, featuring nine lighted tennis courts, called the Clarence "Candy" Greeman Tennis Center. Where many city and school tennis tournaments are held.

30 Riverview Park

Located on 11 acres at 2nd & Chestnut, Riverview Park features a statue of George Rogers-Clark overlooking the river.

31 South Park

Located on 135 acres located at 12th & Harrison, features rolling hills and paths.

32 Sunset Park

Located on 14 acres of natural beauty at 3rd & Cedar, this park is popular for its spectacular plant life.

33 The Quincy Art Center

Housed in the former carriage house in the rear of the Lorenzo Bull Park, a museum of the visual arts.

34 Villa Kathrine

A 4 acre park located on Gardner Expressway, a Moorish-style structure built in 1900 by the wealthy & eccentric George Metz.

35 Washington Park

Located in the Historic Quincy Business District on 4 acres at 5th Street between Maine & Hampshire. The park is popular for many community events, such as Blues in the District & the Farmers Market.

36 Wavering Park

Located on 47 acres in the 1200 block of North 36th Street, features baseball/softball diamonds, playground, restrooms and 2 shelter houses with grills.

37 Westview Park

Located on 12 acres at 30th & Harrison Street, features open fields.

38 Westview Golf Course

Located at 2150 South 36th, this 27-hole golf course will challenge the skilled player or provide an enjoyable experience for the average player or beginner.

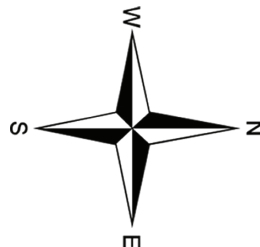

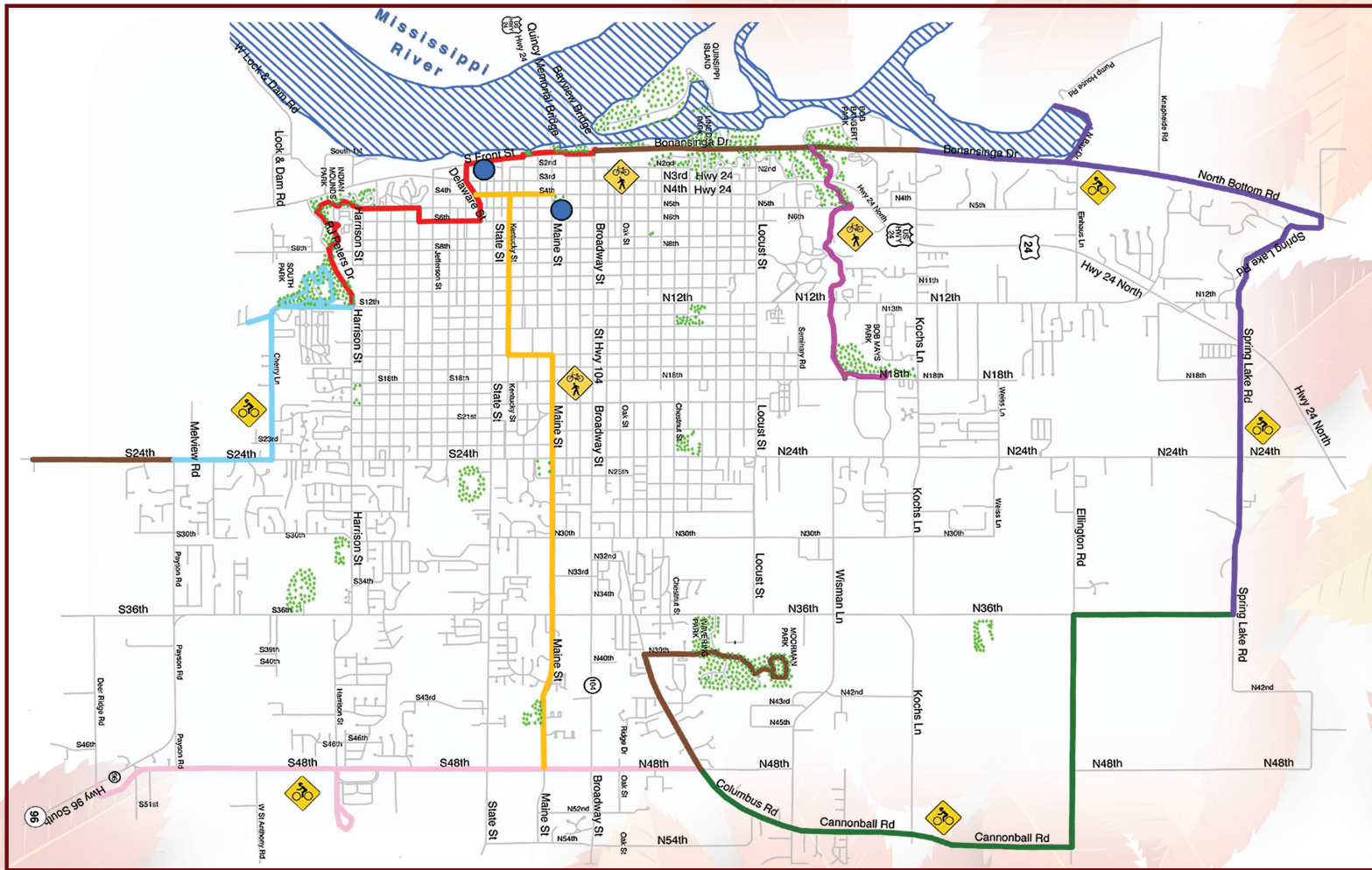

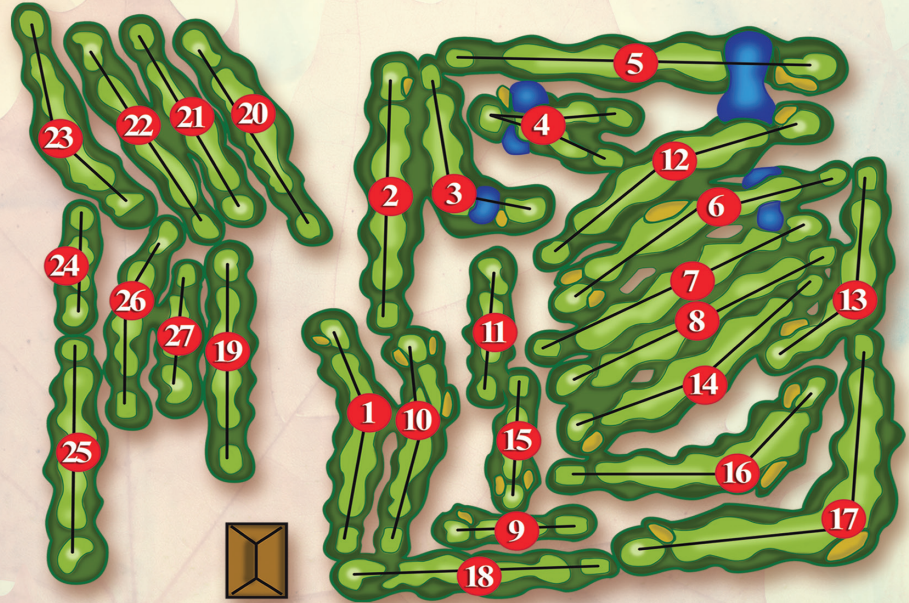
The Players Grill

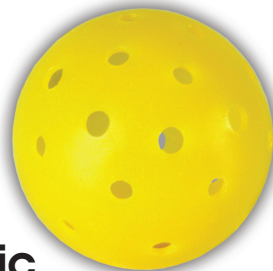
